



BIKE REPAIRS

Rules for Bicycle Repair by The Sheltering Tree

- Hours for repairs are from 9:00AM to 12:00PM on 1st & 3rd Tuesdays, at the Sheltering Tree office location, weather permitting.
- Owners of bicycles wishing to receive repairs must first register with The Sheltering Tree volunteers. (Either in Fellowship Hall or Office #5)
- One bicycle per person. This is a service for your bicycle only, owner must be present.
- Do not leave bicycle unattended, owner is remain with bicycle at all times. We do not watch, check-in or lock bicycles. You are responsible for it.
- Remove all personal belongings from bicycle and unlock the chain. We are not responsible for personal property stolen or damaged.
- The order of repairs is generally first come, first served. Mechanic may change order at his discretion or due to backlog.
- Parts used in repairs may be used or salvaged from other bicycles at the discretion of the mechanic.
- Repairs do not include, lights, bells, horns, any electronics or repair to motor systems. **WE DO NOT WORK ON MOTORIZED BIKES.**
- We do not lend out tools.
- We do not give out parts. All parts must be installed on a bicycle by the Sheltering Tree mechanic.
- Extensive repairs (those estimated to take longer than 30 minutes) or those requiring other services will not be performed at this location.
- There are no charges for repairs but contributions to the Bicycle parts repair fund are welcomed and accepted.
